

Important Advisory for Students & Parents (As per CBSE–UGC Guidelines)

The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), in coordination with the University Grants Commission (UGC), has issued an advisory to create awareness among students and parents regarding fake, self-styled, and unrecognized Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs).

The UGC regularly updates the list of recognized and fake universities on its official website. Admission to unrecognized institutions may adversely affect a student's academic progress, career prospects, and future opportunities.

As the admission process for the Academic Session 2026–2027 is currently underway, students and parents are strongly advised to exercise caution while seeking admission to colleges and universities.

Key Instructions:

- * Students, especially of Classes X and XII, must verify the recognition status of any Higher Educational Institution before applying.
- * Admissions should be taken only in UGC-recognised institutions.
- * Avoid misleading advertisements, agents, or unofficial claims.
